

Severe weather procedure Winter 2010

Procedure to follow when snow has fallen overnight

Mr Richard Jones (Caretaker) will try to get to school to check on the conditions in and around the school grounds. (At about 7.30)

Taxi drivers & parents who transport their children

1. Taxi drivers and parents who transport their children to phone the school as soon as possible if they feel that conditions on the roads are too dangerous.
2. Don't phone to see if the school is open or not or if you are on the way in to school with the children.
3. Parents and taxi drivers are asked to tune in to Heart Radio 103 or Radio Wales or Radio Cymru and check to see if the school is open or not. Or check out school closures on the BBC website; <http://news.bbc.co.uk/1/hi/wales/8444135.stm>

Parents

1. Parents are asked to be patient and wait for the usual transport to arrive.
2. Listen to Heart Radio 103 or to Radio Wales or Radio Cymru to see if the school is open or not. Or check out school closures on the BBC website; <http://news.bbc.co.uk/1/hi/wales/8444135.stm>
3. Contact your usual taxi company if you feel that the roads around your house are dangerous.
4. Please do not phone the school to see if the school is open or not so that we can keep the lines open. BE PATIENT!

Procedure to follow when it snows during the day

1. Taxi companies to contact the school if they are concerned about the conditions and to make sure that they can transport the children safely home.
2. The school will contact every parent if the school is to close. Please try to make sure there is someone at home if conditions look bad.

It is impossible to please everyone when making decisions about school closure. It is not an exact science but we will do our best to keep the school open.
